Aims with regard to students

- To expose students of architecture, engineering and planning to an international, interdisciplinary design, project and studio exercise in a particular socio-economic and cultural environment and thereby co-operating with schools established on dissimilar traditions
- To enable students in designing projects or developing concepts supporting local inhabitants and institutions of disfavoured geographical regions of the EU despite language barriers, assumed scarce resources and less developed infrastructure and services
- To polarize students between heritage conservation and technological development and its use in tourism and agriculture in a distinct landscape with demographic challenges
- To make student works visible by embedding their concepts, projects and design works in larger international context and connecting them with policy makers and international institutions
- Providing an opportunity that all/the best student works get published and distributed in networks of professionals in architecture, landscape architecture or regional planning
- To test interdisciplinary methods of teaching inspired by VVITA project (<https://sites.google.com/view/vvita/>), coordinated by UAUIM
